



Lenten Series 2017

This year, we are focusing our Lenten Series programs on the theme: "Who Is My Neighbor?" Each program will be held after worship for either brunch or lunch, followed by a speaker and conversation about this topic from various perspectives.

Lent begins with **Ash Wednesday, March 1** with a service upstairs in the chapel/parlor room. We will spend some time in confession, which includes the imposition of the ashes.

- Lent 1 – **March 5** – Laura Glista will talk about putting people in boxes and help us understand how to communicate with others who are different. This includes brunch.
- Lent 2 – **March 12** – Marci Wagner, Director of the Buffalo Peace Center on Camp Rd. in Hamburg, which provides housing for refugees. This includes lunch provided by Lynn Palyszeski.
- Lent 3 – **March 19** – Rev. Carl Horton, Director of the PCUSA Presbyterian Peacemaking Program, will preach in our worship service and speak during a lunch after worship. A spaghetti lunch will be provided by the Deacons.
- Lent 4 – **March 26** – Bayram, from the Islam community, will talk to us about what people of the Muslim faith believe. This includes brunch.
- Lent 5– **April 2** – Rev. John Long, retired PCUSA pastor, will talk with us about his work with refugees in Buffalo. This includes brunch.
