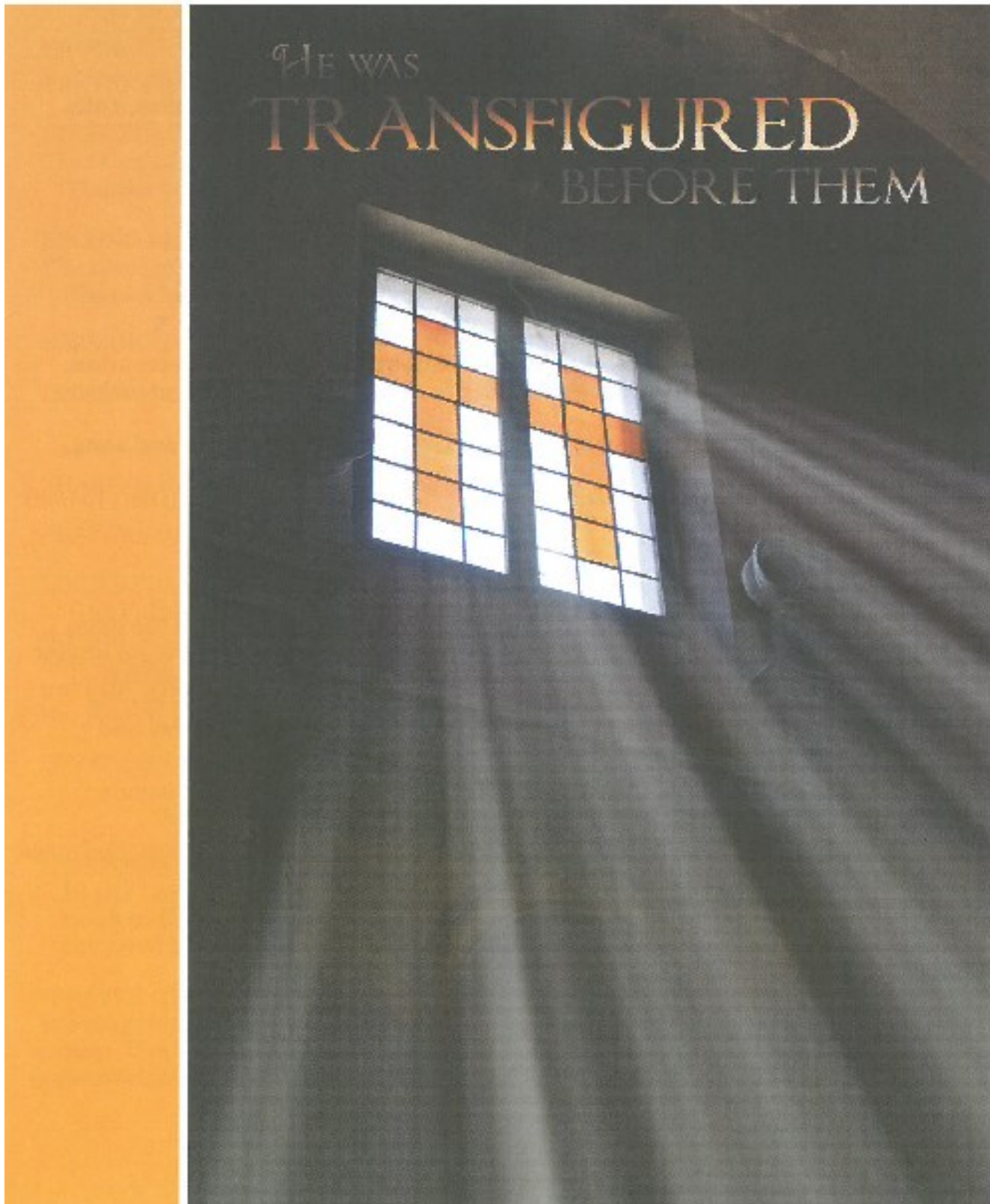

May the peace of Christ be with you.

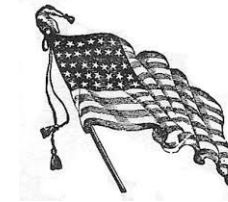
